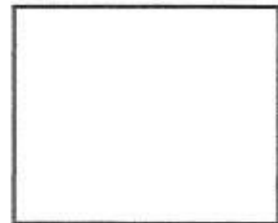

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

(Full compliance with the following will avoid delay in processing)

In executing this application, all information requested must be supplied. This information, with that provided by the applicant's references, is the basis on which a membership grade is recommended to the Board of Directors by the Membership Committee. Use typewriter (preferably or print).

The applicant should give the attached reference sheet to the person he indicated under table 3 who in turn should transmit it to the PSVARE Secretariat.

The applicant should note particularly the certification that... "if offered membership, he/she agrees to accept the grade which is voted by the Board of Directors," and application must be signed by the individual before it is submitted to the Society.

INSTRUCTION FOR TABLE 2 – DEGREE OF RESPONSIBILITY

SUB-PROFESSIONAL WORK is to cover time in engineering work under direct supervision or on work where responsibility and technical knowledge required are small; that is, position in which responsibility is slight and individual performance, set and supervised by a superior, is all that is required.

RESPONSIBLE CHARGE OR WORK means:

- a. *In the field*, applicant must have had the direction of engineering work, the successful accomplishment of which rested upon him/her. Where he/she had to decide questions of methods of execution and suitability of materials, without relaying upon advice or instructions from a superior, and of supplying deficiencies in plans or correcting errors in design without first referring them to higher authority for approval, except in cases where such approval is a matter of form.
- b. *In engineering teaching*, applicant must have taught in an engineering school of recognized reputation, and must have had, at least, a position of assistant professor, or its equivalent.
- c. *In the Office*, and in research and development, applicant must have had to undertake investigations or carry out important assignments, demanding resourcefulness and originality or to make plans, write specifications and direct the drafting and computations for designs of engineering work, with only rough sketches, general information and field measurements for reference and guidance.
